We need your proxies!

The proxies for the Region II conference (San Diego) and the Annual Business Meeting (Phoenix) were mailed to District 49 club presidents on Friday, March 30. The mailings were sent to the most recent club president on file for each Toastmaster club and mailed in a blue envelope with the words "IMPORTANT PROXY INFORMATION" imprinted on the front of the envelope. These proxies are very important to the representation of your club and District 49 in Region and International voting, including International Officers, and dues and bylaws changes. Clubs are free to attend Regional Conference and International Convention and vote their proxies, but many aren't able to.
